Saigon in flames! A band of about two hundred

Viet Cong - breaking through allied defenses today,

Setting fire to whole blocks of buildings -- as they

swept through the city. Trapping thousands of refugees

in the swirling battle. Refugees forced to watch

helplessly - as their homes burned before their eyes.

In the end - about fifty thousand more civilians fleeing to allied strongholds in Central Sakgon. Those who were able to make it - through the crossfire; where the US command was throwing another two thousand troops -- into the battle for the capital. Octually a series of battles - now ring the city.

For all this - U. S. officials calling the Red offensive - merely an harrassing attack. Noting, what's more, that enemy deaths - are running ten to one over Allied losses. One US spokesman saying it is simply - a "murderous Communist publicity stunt."

PARIS FOLLOW SAIGON

From the sound of it - maybe more of the same today in Paris, With the arrival of North Vietnam's chief negotiator - for those upcoming preliminary peace talks.

In the first place - Xuan Thuy (Swahn Twee) calling the talks themselves - a "sign of American military defeat." Everyone knows" - said he -"that the United States has sent more than half a million troops and tens of thousands of satellite troops - woo for its aggression against South Vietnam -- also North Vietnam. But the American war policy has met with increasingly henri heavier defeats" - said Thuy. Adding that Hanoi is thus ready to begin formal peace talks -- as soon as the United States an agrees to a full bombing halt over the North.

HARRIMAN FOLLOW PARIS

U.S. Chief negotiator Averell Harriman - arriving in Paris a few hours later. Telling an airport press conference -- that "no man & sincerely desires peace" as much as President Johnson. Adding, nevertheless, that Americans are pledged to seek "an honorable settlement -- nothing less" no matter how long - it may take.

Meanwhile, back in Saigon -- South Vietnamese

President Theix Thieu was also taking note of the Paris

talks. Telling his people over nationwide television
that the Thieu government will never cede any territory

to the North Vietnamese -- will never form a coalition

including the Viet Cong -- will never enter into

negotiations with the national liberation front.

Thieu adding that lasting peace in Vietnam can come only from direct talks between Saigon and
Hanoi. In the meantime, - said he - "the Communist
strategy is to attack and negotiate at the same time."

Warsaw -- western diplomats and foreign residents

-- barred today from leaving the Polish capital. Why they were not told. However, the travel ban - simultaneous
with a five-nation Communist summit conference in
Moscow. The Soviets and their satellites - reportedly
trying to decide what to do about maverick Czechoslovakia.
The two items together - raising speculation that
Russia's two divisions in Poland - are taking up new
positions near the Czech border.

Across the Frontier - in Prague -- a Czech radio broadcast was also concerned with the Soviet threat. Appealing "for God's Sake" against any repetition of Soviet intervention - such as occurred in Hungary in Nineteen Fifty-Six. If there are differences - said Prague - let them be settled with "clear and unambiguous words" - rather than sudden, dramatic action.

Concession at Cairo. Egypt finally agreeing today

-- to take part in a Mideast peace parley; as long as

it's held in New York - under U N auspices; with the

understanding there will be no direct talks - between

Arabs and Israelis.

This new position - relayed to visiting UN

peace Envoy Gunnar Jarring, Who is also said to have

secured similar approval - from both Israel and Jordan &

Only yesterday - Richard Nixon charged that

-- under the Johnson administration. Today - President

Johnson address himself to the same subject. Vrging

months now.
