GOOD EVENING EVERYBODY:

Secretary of State Dulles laid it on the line tonight in a warning to the Chinese Reds. Although he repeated our desire for peace, the emphasis of the speech was on what we will do if Mao Tse Tung starts a war.

Secretary Dulles announced that he would regard any new attack by the Chinese Reds in Asia as part of a blueprint for conquest. He said that we would act accordingly - with what he termed "new and powerful weapons".

Secretary Dulles even went so far as to point out that Communist China is vulnerable from three sides - from the south, center, and north - because we have defense alliances with nations of southeast Asia, with south Korea, and with the Chinese Nationalists on Formosa.

Our Secretary declared bluntly that Mao Tse Tung's transportation system would not be able to bear the strain of defending the three areas.

Speaking of the Seato conference at Bangkok, Secretary Dulles described himself as "greatly impressed" - with the desire of the nations involved to retain their independence. He pointed out that there are grave economic problems in the area. And he added, that Communist threats continue to terrorize peoples, and to shake governments.

But the point of his speech was this - we and our allies are going to defend freedom against aggression by the Communist Chinese. And Secretary Dulles has no doubt at all -- that we are strong enough to preserve that freedom.

The Dulles speech was well received in Congress. Senator Capehart of Indiana praised the Secretary of State for calling the bluff of the Chinese Reds. And Senator Flanders of Vermont called the speech - "a first class

example of negotiating through strength".

The only ~~d~~ⁱssenting opinion came from Senator Morse of Oregon - who thinks that Secretary Dulles skipped ~~past~~^{over} the problem of Quemoi and Matsu.

MATSU

Today, the British government publicly called on the Generalissimo to evacuate the two key islands of Matsu and Quemoy. The demand, coming from Anthony Eden, speaking in the House of Commons.

~~Sir Anthony~~ ^{Eden} emphasized that he spoke for Britain.

But ~~he~~ argued that right now, the conditions don't exist for a peaceful solution to the Formosa crisis. And he gave two suggestions. One, that the Nationalist Chinese hand Matsu and Quemoy over to the Reds. And secondly, that Mao Tse-Tung make some kind of a gesture to show that he wants peace in the Far East.

VIET NAM

A dispatch from Saigon tells of more violence in Viet Nam. Two pitched battles between government forces and members of the powerful religious sects that dominate so much of the country south of the border.

One battle close to the border - at Balang, four hundred miles from Saigon. Ten rebels killed; seventy-five captured.

The other clash in the far south. A report that twenty-three rebels were killed there.

Prime Minister Dinh Diem has ordered his army to destroy the rebel bands. The religious sects that are fighting him - hope to persuade absentee ~~Emperor~~ Emperor Bau Dai to return from France, hoping the playboy emperor will take over the government, and oust the Premier.

BEVAN

The leaders of the British Labor Party have decided to recommend the expulsion of Aneurin Bevan. So stated by sources close to Clement Attlee.

According to these sources, the decision to ask ~~for~~ for Bevan's expulsion was taken at a meeting of the "shadow cabinet", the men who would take office with Attlee if the Laborites should win the next election. The "shadow cabinet" is described as furious with Bevan - because he publicly defied Attlee's leadership in the House of Commons on Wednesday. The stormy petrel from Wales, refusing to vote for a labor motion to censure the Churchill government. Bevan even insulted Attlee - by asking what the motion meant. And more than sixty other Socialists joined Bevan in abstaining - a real blow to Attlee's prestige.

That's why the Attlee wing wants Bevan expelled.

The struggle within the party comes just when the Socialists need all their strength - for the general election that is expected this year.

LABOR PARTY

Britain's Labor Party is demanding that Churchill press for an early top level conference of the Big Three. Top laborites, led by Clement Attlee, approving a motion calling for talks between Churchill, Bulganin and Eisenhower.

The labor demand will be presented in the form of a motion in the ~~House~~ House of Commons. London politicians predict that Churchill won't be much opposed to this motion -- because a Big Three meeting is just what he has been calling *now for several* ~~for during the past two~~ years. So the motion will strengthen Churchill's hand, even though it's intended as criticism of the Conservatives.

EHRENBURG

A famous Russian journalist warns Britain about the effects of an atomic war. Ilya Ehrenburg telling the Soviet Union peace committee, that ~~no~~ two or three hydrogen ~~no~~ bombs could destroy an island as populated as Britain.

Ehrenburg singled out Sir Winston Churchill - referring to the British Prime Minister's speech in which he said Britain would go ahead with atomic experiments. ^{Ehrenburg} ~~EndxRh~~ thinks that Churchill isn't clear about what this means. So the Soviet journalist warns about the effects of an atomic war-implying, that Russia has enough bombs to destroy Britain in case of an all-out war.

BISSONNETTE

Tonight we know why the American Catholic priest, Father Georges Bissonnette, was expelled from Moscow. The Soviet government presented a note to our Embassy - and it was relayed to Washington. According to the note, Father Bissonnette, as we supposed, was ordered to leave because we refused to let a top figure of the Russian Orthodox Church stay here beyond the time of his visa.

Rather an odd excuse. The Soviet government, noted for its atheistic materialism - protesting because a member of the Orthodox Church is not permitted to stay in America as long as he wants - after expiration of his visa!

MOROCCO

The French government has sent two companies of specially trained gendarmes to Morocco, to put down the wave of terrorism in that area of North Africa. The new force is ~~the~~ made up of four hundred men semi-military police - to help other French anti-terrorist forces in Morocco.

In the latest violence, three Arabs were killed, and two wounded. One of the deaths, attributed to the terrorists the other two to the loyalist vigilantes who help patrol the outlying areas. And last night, gunmen in a speeding car fired on a French police patrol, but there were no casualties.

A dispatch from Jerusalem indicates that the death of five Arabs in Jordania[^] Palestine last week may have been the result of a private feud. Meaning, ^{no national} ~~there was were no~~ political implications attached to the atrocity.

PRINCESS MARGARET

London welcomed Princess Margaret home today.

Thousands crowding the streets to cheer the Queen's sister home from the Caribbean.

When the Princess drove through the streets to a luncheon with the Lord Mayor, London Bobbies had to lock arms to keep the crowds from swarming around the limousine of the Princess. At the Mansion House, Lord Mayor, Sir Seymour Howard, led the cheers for his guest.

Meanwhile, the Daily Mirror printed an interview with Captain Peter Townsend - with whom Princess Margaret has been linked in the past. The R.A.F. captain shifted to a post in Brussels in Nineteen Fifty-Three - with rumors that the royal family wanted him out of the way - because he is divorced. So to many Britons, it seemed undignified for a member of the Royal Family to be talked about as his romantic interest.

Now the rumor is starting all over again - and the Mirror says that its correspondent mentioned to Captain Townsend that a lot of people say Princess Margaret will give up her rights to the throne to marry him. He was asked to give some statement about this. But all he would say was "the word cannot come from me." And that, of course, was no denial at all. So Captain Townsend's answer has stirred up more speculation. Will Princess Margaret marry a commoner? And give up her claim to the throne. After all she is not next in line. So, the Princess may not mind giving up something as vague as her right to the British crown. She'll still be a princess, Hugh, even if she does marry an R.A.F. captain.
