The White House - President Ford today signed into law ^{the} ~~that~~ bill extending unemployment compensation for up to thirteen additional weeks. The President calling the bill a tribute to "the close cooperation" that can exist - "between the Congress and the administration."

"Fortunately" he continued - "we are now seeing signs in the economy that the worst ~~is~~ of the downturn is over - and that recovery has already begun."
