The Spy - is in the sky. The satellite, called "Midas Number Two", launched successfully at Cape Canaveral, today. A two-and-a-half ton man-made moon - crammed with subtle scientific instruments, Fo detect - missile firings and atomic explosions. Equipped - with a sort of magical eye. Doing its detective work - by means of infra red radiation.

Tonight, the "Spy in the Sky" is in orbit - flashing a series of signals. The exact orbit - not immediately determined, Because of the failure at a ground installation in California, where the computer - went out of whack, temporarily.

But the calculated orbit is pretty much - around the Equator. Soviet Russia - not within the range of that infra red eye.

But Today's launching marks the beginning - of a satellite inspection system, Which, it is hoped, will spot Do it evidence of possible surprise attack. Far better than the any surreptitious flights - of the U-2type planes. U.N.

At the U.N., Britain and France, today, told Gromyko -that he hasn't made a case, In his charge of aggression against the United States. The British and French ambassadors to the U.N., addressing the Security Council, stated that those espionage flights did not constitute - a threat to world peace.

They told Gromyko that the Soviets have exaggerated and did it that incident of the U-2 -- out of all proportion. For the purpose - of wrecking the summit conference. They'll vote against the Gromyko motion - to condemn the United States as an aggressor. Argentina and Nationalist China say - they, too, will vote against it. Which means - the Soviet resolution will surely be defeated.

Meanwhile, U.S. Ambassador Henry Cabot Lodge has presented the U.N. with records of eleven Soviet spies -- who have been caught in the United States in the past seven years. So they should talk - about espionage.

In other words, they scream about the U-2 - and we say "you too."

PLANE

A party of Americans, today, went on a mission - to bring back the nine prisoners - Arrested by the Russians when their transport plane lost its way, Straying - into territory of Communist East Germany. They are to be picked up at the same place where they were forced down - by Red fighters.

The note of the Russian command in Berlin conciliatory. Making a mild protest - against the border violation. No sign - of handing the prisoners over to the East German Reds who make the Americans - deal with them. Instead, the Russian message said - come and get the

prisoners. Specifying - that they would be handed over at the wheat field, where the plane came down.

CONGRESS

The Senate Foreign Relations Committee will hold hearings - to determine what happened In the affair of the U-2 - and the collapse of the summit. The proceedings to begin - on Thursday. In

Becret hearings. - But, reports of the testimony will be given out promptly. As soon as the transcripts can be censored in the interests of national security.

(Today, Committee Chairman Senator Fulbright of Arkansas said - the first witness will be Secretary of State Christian Herter. Others to testify will be Allen Dulles, head of the Central Intelligence Agency;- and Secretary of Defense Thomas Gates. Perturbate also, members of the Joint Chiefs of Staff.)

Congressional Democrats, wanting to get the facts are encouraged by Republican Governor Rockefeller of New York. That statement of his calling for an examination of the charges of mistakes and blundering. Nelson Rockefeller urging - a sound, non-partisan appraisal.

EISENHOWER

At the White House - word that plans for President Eisenhower's trip to Japan have not been changed. He'll still go - in spite of disturbing word from Tokyof where the hippon Socialists have announced - that there may be hostile demonstrations, if he makes the projected vinit. The Left Wingers declaring - that the safety of the President could not be guaranteed in Japan.

This is accompanied by news - of more demonstrations against the Japanese-American Security Treaty.

TIDAL WAVE

The Pacific Ocean is churning tonight - in a cresendo of indescribable fury. Tidal waves - raging across the biggest ocean - on our planet. A series - of tidal waves, Some, thirty feet high - traveling at five hundred miles an hour. Dattering islands and continents in a gigantic arc - five thousand miles long. New Zealand - one tidal wave carried thousands of eels ashore. The eels, left floundering - in a farmer's potato field. Another wave - bringing to light a ship lost - more than a century ago. The "H.M.S. Buffalo" - was on the run between New Zealand and London - in the early Nineteenth Century. Disappearing, during a voyage to London - in EighteenForty. Just discovered now. Her wreckage, coming to light - when one of today's tidal waves - pulled the mud off the wreck. The latest - more earthquakes in Chile. The tremors hitting at ten-minute intervals, Kausing - more landslides, Burying - more villages, Setting up - new tidal waves -- in the Pacific.

NAZI

In the old Palestine seaport of Jaffa, a courtroom scene. Adolf Lichmann - facing an Israeli judge. Eichmann - the notorious Nazi war criminal, sought - for fifteen years, reported - to be in Egypt, South America, Arabia. Captured at last - by the Israeli secret police.

Fifty-four years old, neatly dressed - Eichmann stood at rigid attention, as the Israeli judge recited the charge, one clause of which read: "causing the death of millions of Jews."

He was the head of anti-Semitic activities during the Nazi regime. One story being - that he offered to trade. One million Jewish lives - for ten thousand military trucks. This - at a time when the Hitler forces were desperately in need of motor transport.

In Israel, the details of his capture are kept a secret. But the World Jewish Congress in London indicates that Eichmann was detected - in Israel. If

true, what a strange turn of drama! He had learned both Hebrew and Yiddish. Speaking those languages fluently. Which would have enabled him to hid himself in Israel. Arch anti-Semite - passing as a Jewish citizen. And now - Dick Noel.

VETO

Today, the Senate upheld - President Eisenhower's veto of the Depressed Area bill. Which would have put up two-hundred-and-fifty-one million dollars in federal aid - for sections where unemployment is chronic. The President called the measure "wasteful spending." Nobody expected the veto to be overturned. The Democrats making the attempt - for campaign electioneering purposes. So they brought the matter to a vote - and a two-thirds majority could not be obtained. Which surprised - practically nobody. The vote - a mere majority. Forty-five to thirty-nine.
