MASSER, AS YOU'LL RECALL, FIRST ANNOUNCED THAT HE WAS GOING TO "NATIONALIZE" THE CANAL AND BUY THE STOCK FROM THE BRITISH, FRENCH, DUTCH AND OTHER STOCK-HOLDERS.

BUT BEHIND THE SCENES--HIS POLICE AND TROOPS ALREADY WERE TAKING OVER THE VITAL INSTALLATIONS.

HIS OFFICIALS WHO TO BEEN DISPATCHED TO SEIZE THE
CAIRO OFFICES OF THE CANAL COMPANY WERENT TOLD WHAT THEY
WERE SUPPOSED TO DO. THEY WERE HANDED SEALED ENVELOPES, AND
TOLD TO WAIT OUTSIDE THE OFFICES TILL MASSER OUT TO A CERTAIN
POINT IN HIS BROADCAST FROM ALEXANDRIA. THEN-THEY OPENED THE
ENVELOPES-GOT THEIR INSTRUCTIONS AND MOVED IN.

IN LONDON--PRIME MINISTER EDEN'S GOVERNMENT WAS OUTRAGED
-- CALLED THE SEIZURE AN ARBITRARY ACTION FOR WHICH THE EGYPTIAN
GOVERNMENT WILL BE HELD RESPONSIBLE.

AN OFFICIAL NOTE SAID: "ITS A SERIOUS THREAT TO THE FREEDOM
OF NAVIGATION ON A WATERWAY OF VITAL INTERNATIONAL IMPORTANCE."

EDEN ALSO REVEALED THAT HE HAS A PLAN WHICH MAY FORCE NASSER INTO A CHANGE OF HEART--OR AT LEAST A COMPROMISE. HE MAY BLOCK THE STERLING BALANCES OF EGYPT--SOME 300-MILLION-DOLLARS, NOW IN ENGLAND--MONEY IT WOULD TAKE YEARS FOR EGYPT TO REPLACE THRU TAXES OR INCOME FROM THE SEIZED CANAL.
