KOREA SHIP

Off Hong Kong, today, a British Navy launch was bombarded by a Chinese Communist warship. An officer and five sailors killed - according to reports. The British Navy issues only a brief communique - stating that the launch was attacked in the estuary of the Pearl River, between Hong Kong and Portuguese Macao. There is no indication why the Reds, ~~in a landing~~ ~~craft~~ opened fire. Nor are we told whether the British launch sank, was towed back to port, or what.

~~(This news is accompanied by word of still another attack on a British Naval vessel - this one by ~~the~~ Chinese Nationalists. They fired at a destroyer, which was convoying two British freighters, suspected of transporting supplies to the Chinese Communists.~~

The British assailed from both sides -- in the complicated situation along the China coast.)

TOKYO-GI

ISRAEL

FRANCE - TAXES

The French government at last cracking down on wealthy tax dodgers. In a series of raids on fashionable beach resorts and smart gambling casinos. In France, it has long been a scandal - the way the rich duck the tax collector.

One way of judging income is to check on spending. So revenue agents from Paris did a sleuthing job at sumptuous resorts - especially along the Riviera. Taking note of heavy spending, big money gambling, costly automobiles, and expensive yachts.

Today, the Ministry of Finance told of one Parisian who paid no tax at all. - no income, apparently. But he had three of the finest European automobiles, and a luxury apartment, with servants. So on the basis of his spending, they figure he must have an income of at least 20 million francs - fifty thousand dollars a year.

Another said his income was only nine hundred and twenty-nine dollars a year. But he had two cars and

four servants. Still another was the proud possessor of two sumptuous villas on the Riviera, and had recently bought a flashy new automobile. What did he say? Oh, he said he "forgot" all about the little matter of taxes.

COBALT BOMB

London reports agitation over - the "cobalt bomb". Rumors - that British scientists are going to test a new type of atomic weapon -- something even more devastating than the A-bomb or the H-bomb. The element - cobalt -- being the principle. Taking the place of Uranium in the A-bomb; of hydrogen in the H-bomb. The scientists -- discovering weird explosive possibilities in cobalt, a - C-bomb - cosmic in its effect.

To be tried out in Australia - where explosions will be staged next month, on the Woomera rocket range. All of which has the Australians worried. Maybe it will blow kangaroos from Woomera to Timbuctoo.

Recently, a British scientist made the declaration - that an atomic explosion of cobalt could even poison the whole of this Earth's atmosphere with radioactive particles.

Herbert Evatt, leader of the opposition in the

Australian parliament, insists - the London government must give assurance that no C-bomb will be exploded in Australia.

There is no definite evidence that the British have a cobalt bomb. But the uproar is now so loud, that the majestic London Times comes forth on the subject. Urging - that the required assurance be given. "It certainly would help to insure the good-will of the Australian people" quotes the London Times today.

SUPREME COURT

Word from Washington is that Chief Justice Vinson may be succeeded by a top ranking jurist -- not a prominent political figure. This comes from what are called "informed sources", and would rule out Governor Warren of California and Governor Dewey of New York. Both of whom are being mentioned for the Supreme Court post. Earl Warren and Tom Dewey have had their famous careers in state ^{government -} ~~governments~~ not on the judicial bench.

If a number one judge is to be named, indications point toward Arthur Vanderbilt, Chief Justice of the New Jersey Supreme Court. And - Federal Circuit Court Judge John J. Parker of Charlotte, North Carolina. Judge Parker, in fact, almost entered the Supreme Court twenty-two years ago. President Herbert Hoover nominated him in Nineteen Thirty-One, but he was rejected by the Senate - then controlled by the Democrats, and bitterly hostile to President Hoover.

(The belief is that President Eisenhower will

not name a successor to Chief Justice Vinson in a hurry. They say he first will consult with Attorney General Brownell and with Republican leaders in Congress. Announcing his decision - not until the end of this month.)

HURRICANE

A plane on weather survey out in the Atlantic, East of the Bahamas, today, An East wind blowing, at about forty-five miles an hour.
