PENTAGON FOLLOW CAPITOL HILL

For the Pentagon also disclosed today - that a re-appraisal of the study is proceeding faster than expected; with the whole job - expected to take a good deal less than the forty-five days originally anticipated. A Pentagon spokesman further saying: "We estimate that the vast bulk of it - will be cleared."

The House rejecting roday a Senate-passed amendment to the pending draft bill; the one that would have called for total withdrawal of all U S forces in Vietnam - subject only to the release of U S prisoners of war. The house saying no to that - by a margin of two-nineteen to one-seventy-six.
