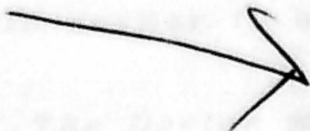


LOS ANGELES ~~follow Boston~~

BOSTON

Meanwhile - surrender at Boston; with

~~Doctor Daniel~~ Ellsberg - turning himself over to  
federal authorities; <sup>and,</sup> on the way in - admitting it was  
he who leaked those Pentagon papers. Adding: "I am  
prepared to answer to all the consequences."

of unauthorised possession and retention of documents

## CAPITOL HILL

At the same time, the Pentagon was delivering ~~today~~ to Capital Hill - twin copies of the full forty-seven volume report. One set - to Senate President pro-tem ~~Allen~~ Ellender of ~~Ark~~ Louisiana; the other - to House Speaker Carl Albert. ~~With~~ the documents still stamped "top secret" - but now available to congressional scrutiny.

Along the way, a reporter asking, <sup>"</sup>Senator Ellender ~~— "Senator,~~ with one hundred Senators reading these documents - do you think they will remain secret?" To which the Senate Chief ~~man~~ replied: "If I'm to judge from past experience around here - the answer is n o."

**PENTAGON FOLLOW CAPITOL HILL**

*But this - largely academic it seems.*

*For the Pentagon also disclosed today - that a re-appraisal of the study is proceeding faster than expected; with the whole job - expected to take a good deal less than the forty-five days originally anticipated. A Pentagon spokesman further saying: "We estimate that the vast bulk of it - will be cleared."*

## SUPREME COURT

*In the nation's capital the Supreme court rules; but not - as you know by now - in the case of those disputed Pentagon papers; a matter which was held in abeyance - "pending further orders."*

*Nevertheless, the high court today <sup>was</sup> disposing of a number of cases - of widespread public interest.*

*Number one - a verdict that makes it unconstitutional - for states to provide money for the direct use of Roman Catholic and other church operated schools; this - up through the high school level.*

*The Supreme Court also throwing out the conviction of former heavyweight champion Mohammad Ali for refusing his draft induction. Further agreeing to rule next fall on the constitutionality of the death penalty.*

# HOUSE

The House <sup>has</sup> ~~rejecting today~~ <sup>ed</sup> a Senate-passed

amendment to ~~the~~ <sup>the</sup> pending draft bill; the one that would

have called for total withdrawal of all U S forces in

Vietnam - subject only to the release of U S prisoners

of war. The house saying no to ~~that~~ <sup>it</sup> - by a margin

of two-nineteen to one-seventy-six.

NEW YORK CITY

*New York City - an attempt today on the life of the reputed Mafia leader Joseph Colombo Senior; who was shot in the head by a black assailant. This during a giant Italian-American Unity Day rally.*

*Colombo's attacker was then shot and killed either by police - or bodyguards. The dead man later identified as Jerome Jackson - aged twenty-four -- of New Brunswick, New Jersey. According to a later anonymous phone call - <sup>he was</sup> a member of the so-called "black revolutionary attack team."*

VIETNAM

Salyut cosmonauts today completed their twenty-third day in orbit. Setting a new space endurance record - with every <sup>circuit;</sup> ~~turn;~~ also, sending back a <sup>lot</sup> ~~number~~ of information - on the physical aspects of prolonged weightlessness. Russian space experts observing: "Every day now - is a step into the unknown."

## SEATTLE FOLLOW SPACE

While here below - at Seattle - a meeting of the World Committee on Space Research; including among its delegates - a trio of Russian space scientists who said that Russia's Soyuz Nine Cosmonauts - who set the previous space endurance record - were unable to walk without help when they first returned to earth.

~~adding that, indeed,~~ it took them eleven days - to re-adjust to gravity -- to resume normal physical activity. And even then ~~we are told~~ - they "felt their heads, limbs and objects they used" were twice as heavy as normal.

With a fire control officer at Pecos, New Mexico, observing sadly: "The Nineteen Seventy-One fire season - is already one of the worst in this century."
