PEKING

Red China today condemned India's announced plan - to ~~virtually~~ absorb its one time ~~of~~ protectorate the Himalayan Kingdom of Sikkim. Peking saying the India action - has "shocked and infuriated all justice-upholding countries and peoples." Adding that India clearly views itself - as a sub-super power. And, "dreams of ~~now~~ lording it over ~~South~~ South Asia."
