The death toll in the Yugoslav Earthquake may go as high as five thousand. The quake that shook
Skopje, a city of two hundred thousand people, where
even massive buildings collapsed. One, the Macedonia
Hotel - with eighty rooms and three hundred guests.
The Hotel went down in a heap of smoking rubble. No
survivors.

Especially poignant - as always, in tragedies like this - the hospitals. The able bodied, leaping out of windows - as the buildings began to shake. The bed ridden trapped where they lay. The corridors - a mass of milling screaming patients. The dispatch tells of many thousands of injured or homeless with the death toll - mounting by the hour. Tonight rescue workers are digging frantically in the ruins, and aid is being rushed from abroad. The U.S. Airforce putting
