STEEL

PROBABLE LEAD STORY.

THE END OF THE STEEL STRIKE APPEARS TO BE CLOSE AT HAND TONIGHT--UNION AND MANAGEMENT REPORTING "FURTHER PROGRESS" IN NEGOTIATIONS TODAY.

EIGHT BARGAINERS-- FOUR FROM EACH SIDE--WORKED ALL DAY IN NEW YORK ON A NEW CONTRACT, AND THE UNION'S WAGE-POLICY COMMITTEE IS SET TO MEET TOMORROW--APPARENTLY TO LOOK IT OVER.

SOME INDUSTRY SOURCES PREDICT IT'LL BE A THREE YEAR CONTRACT--CALLING FOR INCREASES OF NINE OR TEN CENTS AN HOUR, EACH YEAR. BUT THOSE DOING THE BARGAINING WONT TALK ABOUT THAT--NOT YET ANYWAY--NOT UNTIL THERE'S FIRM AGREEMENT TO END THE 25-DAY STRIKE.

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STASSEN ACCUSED REPUBLICAN CHAIRMAN LEONARD HALL OF TRYING TO "FORCE" NIXON ON THE SAN FRANCISCO CONVENTION. STASSEN CALLED IT: "CONTRARY TO REPUBLICAN TRADITION AND ^{usual} practice."
