LONDON DESCRIBES PRESIDENT EISENHOWER'S RADIO-
TELEVISION ADDRESS LAST NIGHT - AS "A REALISTIC
COMBINATION OF FIRMNESS AND FLEXIBILITY."

FIRM - IN STATING THAT THE WEST WILL NOT
"RETREAT AN INCH" FROM ITS DETERMINATION - TO STAY
IN WEST BERLIN, WITH THE RIGHT OF PEACEFUL PASSAGE -
TO AND FROM THE CITY.

FLEXIBILITY - IN STATING THAT HE'S WILLING TO
GO INTO A SUMMIT CONFERENCE WITH SOVIET RUSSIA,
AFTER - A PRELIMINARY MEETING OF THE FOREIGN MINISTERS.
THE PRESIDENT - AGREEING TO TOP LEVEL COLD WAR
NEGOTIATIONS WITH THE RUSSIANS.

"FIRMNESS AND FLEXIBILITY," SAYS LONDON. AN
OPINION ECHOED IN ALL THE CAPITALS OF THE WEST, WHICH
GIVE A WARM WELCOME - TO THOSE EISENHOWER DECLARATIONS.

APPROVAL UNANIMOUS IN OUR OWN AMERICAN CONGRESS.
DEMOCRATS AND REPUBLICANS - JOINING TODAY IN APPROVAL

OF THE PRESIDENT'S WILLINGNESS TO NEGOTIATE AT THE
SUMMIT.

BUT WHAT ABOUT MOSCOW ? NOTHING OFFICIAL - YET.
ALTHOUGH THE SOVIET NEWS AGENCY, TASS, WAS COOL
AND CRITICAL, TODAY. NOTING - THAT PRESIDENT
EISENHOWER MADE NO REFERENCE TO SPECIFIC PROPOSALS
URGED BY KHRUSHCHEV. LIKE - THAT "FREE CITY" NOTION.

HOWEVER, DIPLOMATIC OBSERVERS IN MOSCOW BELIEVE -
KHRUSHCHEV/ WILL ACCEPT. AFTER ALL, HE'S BEEN
AGITATING FOR A SUMMIT CONFERENCE. AND HAS OKAYED -
A MEETING OF THE FOREIGN MINISTERS AS A PRELIMINARY.

THE SPREAD OF NATIONALIST VIOLENCE IN AFRICA¹²
ILLUSTRATED BY AN ERUPTION IN AN AREA, HITHERTO
QUIET. NORTHERN RHODESIA, WHERE, SUDDENLY,
ANTI-WHITE OUTBREAKS WERE NOW REPORTED. TWO BRITISH
OFFICIALS - ATTACKED BY TRIBESMEN WITH SPEARS. BOTH
- INJURED. BRITISH GOVERNMENT BUILDINGS BURNED -
BY MOBS ON THE RAMPAGE.

HITHERTO PEACEFUL NORTHERN RHODESIA^{- now} -[^] INFECTED
BY A SPREAD OF NATIONALIST AGITATION FROM NEARBY
NYASALAND. WHERE FORTY-FOUR LIVES HAVE BEEN LOST
IN DISTURBANCES, ^{with} THE CRY - "WHITES GO HOME."[^]

THE MOST HUNTED MAN IN THE WORLD - AS HE WAS
UNTIL RECENTLY. NOW APPEARING IN PUBLIC -. SURROUNDED
BY SOLDIERS, WHO WERE CHASING HIM ONLY A FEW WEEKS
AGO. COLONEL GEORGE GRIVAS - CHIEF OF THE GREEK
UNDERGROUND ON CYPRUS.

FOR FOUR YEARS, IN HIDING - HE DIRECTED THE
TERRORIST CAMPAIGN AGAINST THE BRITISH, WHO PUT A
PRICE OF TWENTY-EIGHT THOUSAND DOLLARS - ON HIS HEAD.
AS MANY AS THIRTY THOUSAND BRITISH TROOPS - COMBING
THE HILLS AND FORESTS, LOOKING FOR HIM. HOW HE
MANAGED TO AVOID CAPTURE ON A RELATIVELY SMALL ISLAND
LIKE CYPRUS - A MYSTERY.

BUT NOW THE QUARREL HAS BEEN SETTLED - AND,
TODAY, THE MAN OF LEGEND LEFT CYPRUS. FLYING - TO
ATHENS. AT THE NICOSIA FLYING FIELD, BRITISH SOLDIERS
ON GUARD. GAZING - AT THE MYSTERY MAN, WHOM THEY
WERE PURSUING NOT SO LONG AGO.

ARRIVING IN ATHENS, GRIVAS RECEIVED A WELCOME OF A HERO. MILITARY HONORS - AND CHEERING CROWDS, THERE TO GREET HIM - HIS WIFE, WHOM HE HADN'T SEEN - EVER SINCE HE TOOK THE COMMAND OF THE GREEK UNDERGROUND ON CYPRUS, FOUR YEARS AGO.

WORD OF A GET-RICH-QUICK SCHEME -- OF A TIMELY SORT, HAVING TO DO - WITH THE RECENT CUBAN REVOLUTION CLEANING UP - THROUGH DEALS IN CUBAN PESOS.

THE HUGE FINANCIAL GAME - REPORTED BY THE BOSTON TRAVELER. WHICH SAYS - THAT HEADQUARTERS ARE IN BOSTON, NEW YORK AND MIAMI. REFUGEES OF THE FALLEN BATISTA REGIME - UNLOADING FORTUNES IN CUBAN PESOS.

THE BATISTA FUGITIVES - HAVE TAKEN OUT SEVERAL HUNDRED MILLION DOLLARS WORTH, WHICH THEY SELL - AT HALF THE MARKET VALUE. PURCHASES MADE BY AMERICAN SPECULATORS - WHO THEN SMUGGLE THE PESOS BACK INTO CUBA, AND CONVERT THEM INTO DOLLARS AT THE FULL EXCHANGE RATE. PROFIT - ONE HUNDRED PER CENT.

THE BOSTON PAPER SAYS THE SPECULATORS HAVE BEEN INVESTING HEAVILY IN CUBAN REAL ESTATE. SOME - HAVING BOUGHT HAVANA HOTELS. FINANCIAL GIMMICK - FOLLOWING THE DRAMATIC EVENTS IN CUBA.

TRIAL
