***The U S Postal Service today announced a temporary suspension of all mail service from the U S to Canada. This at the request of Ottawa - the result of a fast spreading Canadian postal strike.***

## **CHICAGO**

**Senator Humphry and Democratic national chairman Robert Strauss were the speakers today at the Democratic Governors conference in Chicago. Both urging the Democrats to stop counting on a Watergate backlash to produce a Democratic sweep to Seventy-Six.**

**"In the coming months and years" - said Senator Humphrye - "the American people will expect more from the Democrats - than outrage at Republican scandals."**

## **BANGOR FOLLOW CHICAGO**

*Over the weekend - at Bangor, Maine a meeting of Maine Republicans ending up by endorsing and commending President Nixon - for ending the Vietnam War, improving relations with China, working for welfare reform, ending the draft, reorganizing the Federal bureaucracy and instituting revenue sharing. They also urge a speed-up of impeachment proceedings; so "that responsibility can be determined and the guilty punished - whenever and wherever found."*

## SACRAMENTO

*A penciled note and a tape recorded message said to have come from the Symbionese Liberation Army arrived in the mail today at the Sacramento Bee. The sender - a so-called "General" attempting as he put it - "to prevent the set-up and assassination of the members of the S L A by F<sup>ascist</sup> State Agents:" Warning that "for every S L A member murdered - five California peace officers will be executed."*

## KREMLIN

*Senator Ted Kennedy and family were guests of Leonid Brezhnev today at the Kremlin. The Senator and the Soviet leader - conferring for four hours; an unusually long time. A Kennedy spokesman later saying they both "expressed the deep commitment of their two countries to maintaining peace, to bringing the arms race firmly under control - to working productive relations ~~in~~ in a host of other areas." Brezhnev chatting with newsmen, said he looks forward - to another visit to the U.S. Then adding "not for pleasure - I have no time for pleasure."*
