Federal Judge John Pratt - late this afternoon in Washington issued a temperature order against the United Transportation Union, which is threatening to strike two railroads tomorrow as a means of bringing pressure on the entire railroad industry in a wage dispute. Judge Pratt ruling in effect that it must be all or nothing - if the union orders its men off the job tomorrow, it must strike all American railroads, not just some of them. Thus upholding the industry's argument that - once the union bargained with all the carriers on a national basis - any strike must also be on a national basis.
