Tonight, the capitals of the world are buzzing about what happened at the foreign office in Moscow. Gromyko, replacing Shepilov - who got the job only last June.

The announcement came from the Tass News Agency; with no reason given for Shepilov's demotion. We are merely told that the action was taken at secret meetings of the Central Committee of the Soviet Communist Party. Gromyko has a reputation - as one of the toughest of the old line Communists. Douglas MacArthur the second - newly appointed American Ambassador to Tokyo. He arrives at an akward moment it seems. The Japanese press is playing up two shooting incidents - involving American troops and Japanese civilians. And the Japanese socialists are saying that Washington wants to make an "atomic base" out of Japan. Ambassador MacArthur got a taste of anti-American

feeling when his plane landed. Two hundred students from Tokyo University - demonstrating at the airport. Carrying signs reading: - "Mac, go home!" and "Return Okinawa!"

These demonstrators we are told represent only a small minority, but, as is often true of minorities, they make a lot of noise.

Douglas MacArthur the second also encountered some pro-American feeling in Japan. There were others parading at the airport - calling for stronger ties between Tokyo and Washington. And of course, leaders of the Tokyo government were on hand - including the foreign Minister.

Ambassador MacArthur, unperturbed by all the turmoil, told newsmen he was there to work for a better understanding between Japan and the United States. At any rate that headline has a familiar ring: - Douglas MacArthur in Tokyo!

CIVIL RIGHTS

Attorney General Brownell says - the administration's civil rights program is needed - to prevent what he calls "Mass disenfranchisement of negro voters." Before a senate judiciary sub-committee, Brownell declaring that negroes should be allowed to bring civil suits in the courts - when their voting rights are threatened. He believes this would be more effective than the present system - under which criminal proceedings are brought - after violations have occurred. The attorney General says he can give the subcommittee a list of hundreds of cases - to back up his charge that negroes are being disenfranchised. The vote, taken from them.
