At last - agreement in Berlin. The Big Four Ambassadors finally completing today seventeen months of negotiation; coming up with a tentative solution & to the long standing Berlin problem; a solution said to call for a number of major concessions -- on both sides. These still secret, of coursed course subject to final approval 44 by east and west the Germany as well as the savious Big Four capitals. Diplomatic sources indicating, however, that the west, will get unimpeded access to West Berlin and freer access to East Berlin; also, Russian recognition of the ties that bind West Berlin to West Germany; In return for which the Russian's will supposedly get - a limitation on West German political activity in West Berlin; also, the right to open a consulate, -

in West Berlin.

This marking the first major agreement on the Berlin situation since the lifting of Berlin blockage some twenty-two years ago.

In spite of all the furore last week - the
