

Plans for a sweeping congressional

VIETNAM

In Vietnam -- a bonanza today for American infantrymen; in their game of hide and seek in "War Zone C" -- about seventy-five miles northwest of Saigon; discovering a huge Communist supply center -- near the Cambodian border; believed to be the Southern terminus -- of the vital Ho Chi Minh supply trail; there destroying nearly seven thousand Communist uniforms -- a thousand tors of rice -- more than nine hundred tons of salt; also twenty-five sampans and two vessels -- used to transport the goods.

The supply center -- wide open when the Americans arrived. Defenders had fled across the border.

VIET NAM FOLLOW PENTAGON

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Here at home - a prediction today from the Pentagon- that the full weight of U S military powerin Viet Nam - will be brought to bear against the Viet Course by next October - factor following the monsoon season. With just a chance - an admittedly slim chance - that the war in Viet Nam can be won - by early next year. This predicted on a belief that by fall - Communist manpower losses will exceed their ability to find replacements. This Assuming, in addition, that Red China and Russia - continue to keep "hands off." Even if war is what Sherman said it was, there can be grim humor -- even in the worst situation, as illustrated by two items today.

An American soldier, assigned to an ambush in Viet Cong territory -- was startled by a tap on the shoulder. Whirling around -- he found himself face to face with the enemy; a frightened Viet Cong -- clutching a "safe conduct" pass dropped by a U.S. plane. He wanted to surrender .

And-- another Viet Cong was told by his commanding officer-- to gather up all the "safe conduct" passes he could find. Only trouble -- he later explained --American planes kept dropping so many! Faced with an insurmountable task -- he also surrendered.

WAR

HUMILIATION

The ultimate humiliation today - for Kuo Mo-Jo. A man considered until recently - Red China's leading intellectual.

Beginning of the end - an attack from China's Minister of Culture, accusing Kuo of grossly misrepresenting certain aspects -- of "China's cultural life."

The coup-de-grace - by Kuo himself, quoted Today from Peking word that he guilt, seid to know first further recommended that all he has written --- "chould" be burned as useless."

Kuo - at seventy-four - a past-winner of

China's state peace prize. Also a vice chairman - of the Lenin International Peace Prize Committee. Widelyacclaimed as a poet and historian; - until his fall from official favor.

RANGE

President Johnson - home on the range tonight. The President and his family - star attractions at a gala dinner dance in Houston, for big-money contributors to the Democratic Party & from Texas, Oklahoma, Arkansas, Louisiana and New Mexico.

This the first of several of fund-raising affairs **that** the President will attend during the spring and summers as part of the campaign to help elect Democrats - in the fall elections. A similar dinner planned for Washington May Twelfor - another in Chicago May Seventeenth - and a third in New York early in June.

NORRISTOWN

A weird story of fear, superstition - and murder - comes today from Norristown, Pennsylvania, Following the arrest of twenty-eight year old John Bruno on charges of murdering five of his neighbors.

As reconstructed by police - the series of it all began in Nineteen Sixty-One. The motive supposedly revenge - for real or imagined grievances. Most of the victims - elderly Italians. Their friends and family apparently suspecting Bruno's implication in the crimes - but refusing to call authorities.

Why so? Because - said a policeman - they "were frightened by sorcery, witchcraft and the kikest like, fully convinced that Bruno possessed an "evil eye" - capable of dealing death at a single glance.

INDONESIA

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Another indication today - of Indonesia's changing foreign policy. The Indonesian Army's "Crush Malaysia" command - reporting itself ready as ever for an armed confrontation with Malaysia; adding, however, that it would really prefer - a negotiated settlement of their long-standing feud. This according to a broadcast fox from Radio Jakarta.

Also from Jakarta - news today of a tremendous eruption early this week - at the water-filled Genung Kelud volcano in East Java. Turning a nearby river into a steaming torrent -- and burying the village of Bambunan under a sea of lava. At least thirteen known

dead - plas a wamber missing.

A twenty-one gun salute today in Tehran -- followed by joyous celebration throughout Iran. Marking the birth of another son -- the second -- to Shah Mohammed Reza Pahlevi -the fabled Shah of Shahs; and also, of course, to his wife -- the Empress Farah.

To be named Ali Reza after the Shah's younger brother -- who died in an air crash. The royal couple's two other children -- Crown Prince Reza, who will be six in October -and Princess Farahnaz, now three.

The Shah divorced two previous wives, who failed to produce a male heir. Now two sons available to mount the Peacock Throne in the fabled land where Alex-the-Great defeated Darius-the-Great, at the Battle of Issus, remember Warren?
