U. N.

The Malaysian spokesman in the dispute with Indonesia had some fast questions to answer for the Security Council today -- charges by Russia and Indonesia that British Colonialism is at the bottom of it all.

Said the Malaysian Home Affairs Minister

- Data Ismail - the issue boils down to this: -

Which shall prevail - the U.N. charter or the law of the jungle? Does the Council believe that one member state should attack another - in order to achieve its ends. Has the U.N. ever before heard one of its members categorically state that its foreign policy will be concentrated on - eliminating a peaceful neighbor? A fellow member - of the U.N.? And, further admit it has troops - in its neighbors' territory, and intends to keep them there?

All this according to Minister Data Ismail, points not to British colonialism - but to Indonesian "neo-imperialism." And the diplomat from Kuala Lumpur wants to know -- what the U.N. is going to do about it.

POLICY

President Johnson says the importance of the attempted coup in South Viet Nam - should neither be exaggerated -- or played down. It's just one more symptom, he thinks -- of a problem which will not be solved overnight. The problem of political stability in South East Asia where we are so deeply committed.

The President is still backing Premier Khanh's government. U.S. policies to be as before.

Meanwhile in Saigon Premier Khanh ~~is~~ obviously ~~is~~
^{yet} not out of the woods. ~~is~~ The young loyalist generals
who helped him subdue the uprising - demanding a
reshuffle in the Armed Forces and Civil Service. The
dismissal of - corrupt officers and civil servants.
As well as - punishment for profiteers.

They give Khanh two months - to carry out these
demands. The alternative - another coup. Which the
generals - will join. So Premier Khanh has been
served notice - that he ^{is} ~~is~~ on probation, ~~And~~ -
has to make good.

COUNCIL

In Rome, one of the age-old spectacles -- of the Catholic Church. The Pope, celebrating High Mass -- in Saint Peter's, with the faithful -- inside the historic Cathedral and an even bigger crowd outside - in Saint Peter's Square, before those famous columns by Bernini.

With leaders of the Church of Rome there -- from all parts of the world; Scotland to South Africa - rio to Singapore -- in their brilliant robes. And it may not happen again for a couple of centuries. Ecumenical Councils are few and far between -- in the long history of the Church. So there's an air of excitement as the Second Vatican Council -- begins its final session. The one that will decide the extent to which old practices -- should be modified or dropped. And new ones - adopted.

"The Church must give a definition of itself," said the Pope today.

THIRD FORCE

The latest Red nation to come out in favor of a Communist "Third Force" - ~~is~~ Albania. Rather surprising in view of Tirana's loyalty - to Peking, ~~And~~ Premier Hoxha's long resentment - of Khrushchev's attempt to bring him to heel.

~~Why~~ Why are the Albanian Comrades in favor of - an independent grouping of states between Moscow and Peking? Radio Tirana - is quite candid about that. Hoxha wants the idea applied to Eastern Europe - only. That is - to the satellites of the Soviet Union. The states that are not in a position to defy Khrushchev - because they have the Red Army camped on their soil.

As for the Red nations that side with Mao - the Albanians don't want them to take a neutral position. Radio Tirana, arguing that Mao's Marxism-Leninism - is the correct ideology, ~~And~~ that anyone who rebels against the line laid down in Peking - is a traitor to

the international class struggle.

What would happen if the Albanian argument should be accepted? Nations like North Korea, North Viet Nam - and of course, Albania -- would remain loyal to Red China. Nations like Hungary and Roumania would break their ties with Russia - and join an uncommitted Communist "Third Force." What the Albanian Reds would like to do is isolate Khrushchev.
