NAIROBI

The U.N. parley that Henry Kissinger addressed last week in Nairobi, - still  
in session, <sup>today</sup> ~~hearing today~~ an attack from China's Chou Hua-Min - on the Kissinger  
proposal for a one billion dollar International Resources Bank. Chou saying the  
only purpose of such a bank - would be "to preserve the old order".

He also accused the U.S. and more so Russia - of attempting to reduce poorer  
countries to sheer slavery". This bringing an angry reply - from Russian delegate  
Nikolai Patolichev; who called the Peking stand - a "harbinger of a new world war  
against detente."

PARIS

Bolivia's Ambassador to France, General Joaquim Zenteno Anaya - was shot and killed today on a busy street in Paris. General Zenteno, years ago, the man who directed the search for Cuban revolutionary Che Guevara - in the jungles of Bolivia. Guevara finally captured, then killed, - ~~and~~ today's shooting apparently a revenge murder. A group calling itself "Che Guevara Brigade" claiming responsibility.

MOSCOW-JERUSLEM

From the Kremlin - a "strong protest" today to the U.S. Embassy in Moscow; for U.S. failure to halt attacks on Russians offices and Russian personnel - in New York City.

At the same time - in Jeruslem - an attempt by Isreal to disassociate itself - from the militant Jewish Defense League and its former leader, Rabbi Meir Kahane. Foreign Minister Yigal Allon saying the <sup>League's</sup> ~~JDL's~~ threats of violence - "are intolerable in themselves; and greatly sobotage the struggle of the Jewish people" - in behalf of Soviet jewry.

INCOME

The highest percapita income in the U.S. for years <sup>1971</sup> ~~λ~~ in Washington D.C., where the taxes go, ~~At~~, but a change at last - and the new leader is Alaska. According to figures released <sup>d</sup> ~~λ~~ today, per capita income in Alaska - now nearly nine thousand a year; for a lead of more than a thousand bucks - over second-place Washington.

Alaska also showing the greatest one-year increase in per capita income - nearly eighteen percent. <sup>Due of course to the</sup> ~~As you may have guessed, both figures due mainly to~~ accelerated construction - on the Alaskan pipeline.

A former mental patient armed with a rifle today shot and killed a man and two women - for no apparent reason - in downtown Knoxville. The gunman also wounding two others - then surrendering meekly to police.
