permitting them to abandon their propaganda posture;"

and thereby - "get down to work."

There was a resumption of heavy fighting today

- in the U Minh forest, Vietnam's "Forest of Darkness."

Saigon troops - with the backing of off-shore fire

from the U S Destroyer Epperson killing at least

thirty-five. This raising enemy losses in the U Minh

over the past week - to well over six hundred; as

against government losses put at a hundred and twenty
five.

On the political front - South Vietnam's President Thie u was off campaigning today of at Pleiku in the Central Highlands. About half the members of the South Vietnamese Senate - mainly those who support Thieu to busy elsewhere. This paving the way -- for a special session of the Senate; where a motion was passed -- urging tone Thieu to cancel the upcoming Presidential election and further, calling for a new contest under the auspices of the speaker of the Senate, But most observers say "Not likely."

In the British House of Commons - the start

The Vatican adding that "urgent action must be taken to avoid the population of East Pakistan being

decimated."

Soviel Communist Party Chieftain Leonid

Brezhnev - a visitor today at Belgrade, Jugoslavia;

receiving a royal welcome and an embrace - from

Jugoslavia's President Tito. But Tito stressed in

later remarks that Russian and Jugoslavian cooperation

"is based on equality and mutual respect." Adding

that Jugoslavia remains "an unaligned country."

Incidentally, Brezhnev's airport reception drew less than half the crowd that greeted President
Nixon when he visited Belgrade. Observers noting,
moreover that what little applause there was "mostly for Tito."

At Newport, News, Virginia, First Lady Pat Nixon today christened a new nuclear powered guided missile frigate -- the U S S California. Reaching out and smashing a champagne bottle across the bow - just as the ship began to slip away from her. Navy Secretary John Chafee -- also present, --Expressing hope that "this magnificent man of war" as he put it - "will earn no battle scars; and will never use her missiles - except for the practice required to be keep her sharp and credible; for it would be a tragedy of the first order" - said he -Notes "were she ever to fire her weapons in anger."

This next from San Diego - a chilling item. Dr. Thomas Owen of the National Science Foundation -- reporting that the earth's average temperature has dropped substantially since Nineteen Forty; with the world heading for another ice age. Incidentally, glaciologist Professor Maynard Malcolm Miller of Michigan State made the same prediction two years ago. Does this mean for us all to rush out and buy fur coats? Says Dr. Owens: No hurry. He predicts it will be five thousand years before the ice man cometh. But as your wife always says -- "why wait 'till the last minute."
