arrive in Washington -- April Twenty- second. So announced at the White House today. The French President will stop off in Canada first for a three day visits Then, seven days in the United States. Three -- conferring with President Eisenhower in the national capital. The two historic generals will try to straighten out 4 a series of differences between the French on one side, and the British and Americans on the other. (The United States, for example wants the French Air Force to be integrated into the command of Nato. DeGaulle -- refusing. Then there's the Algerian question. DeGaulle -- disgruntaled because the United States has not supported France more strongly at the U N, In proceedings concerning the rebellion in that North African country.

The hope is that these points of dispute may be cleared up 4 before the summit conference in May, so there the Western Powers can present a United front 44 in dealing with Khrushchev.

At the same time, today, the White House announced that President Eisenhower will visit Latin American countries in late February and early March. Puerto Rico, Argentina, Brazil, Chile -- and Uruguay. The first lady -- to accompany the President on a good will tour, all the way, to lands below the Equator.

Cuba, today, celebrated the feast of the epiphany. Which in Latin America is the traditional day for the exchange of Christmas presents. Castro ordering -- an amnesty for twelve hundred prisoners -- criminals -- to be let out of jail. However, no political prisoners were included among those -- released. Hundreds charged with political offences -- to go on trial. Sixteen more arrests -- reported in the province of Pinar del Rio.

At the same time, measures continue -- to check a possible invasion. Anti-Castro revolutionarie -- who might be expected to land in Cuba. Also precaution against any sabotage of the Cuban sugar crop. These to be protected by what Castro calls -- a people's malitia.

## MACHILLAN

British Prime Minister MacMillan att arrived West Comming in the new Republic of Ghana today. Beginning a hie African tour, Which will take him on a twenty thousand mile circuit -- of that much disturbed continent.

At Accra, the capital of Ghana, he got a chilly welcome. Nothing hostile -- just apathetic. Government officials were at the airport with formal greetings. But the crowds -- virtually non existent, as the Prime Minister drove into the city.

Another story -- of an army deserter of world war two. Widden -- ever since. It happened in Soviet Russia, and the secret was revealed -- as a result of a New Year's party.

In a village near Kharkov, a gathering at the home of a peasant family, where friends and relatives -- drank to the heroic memory of poor Georgi. On record -- and having been killed in the war. But while this was going on -- Georgi was lying in a shed nearby, a shed - for goats. Today Moscow propaganda blamed it on religion. Georgi's family -- devout members of the old Orthodox Church. With no liking for Communism -and they raised Georgi that way. So he deserted from the Red army -- and they hid him in the goat shed. Where he remained concealed we for eighteen years.

Once he got so tired of it he left the goat shed -- intending to give himself up to the authorities. But what did he see? On the roofs

of houses -- crosses. Symbols -- of Christianity.

Which he took as a sign -- and went back to the goat shed. Actually, the crosses were aerials of television sets. But then came in that New Year's party. Georgi hearing himself praised as a war hero who gave his life. That was too much, and out he came, astonishing the visitors.

There's a puzzle - in today's air disaster.

The last message from the pilot of the doomed air liner said - he was flying at eighteen thousand feet over lower North Carolina. No hint - of any trouble. No further message - that might indicate any reason for the crash. When the plane plunged into a North Carolina swamp.

Yet the wreckage reveals that there might have been intimation of trouble. The airliner was approaching the coast, and several bodies were found wearing life jackets. A life raft - inflated. Signs that a landing on the ocean was anticipated. The plane - coming to disaster not far from the shore line. There are indications that it disintegrated in the air. It was a propeller driven plane put on the flight - as a substitute for a jet.

At New York's Idlewild airport, the jet airliner was found to have - a cracked windshield. So passengers

bound for Florida, were transferred to two propeller planes. One - making the trip to Florida without mishap. The other had thirty four aboard - no survivors.

One of the victims, Vice Admiral Orrick McDonnell, retired. A naval hero - of two wars. Decorated with the Congressional medal of honor.
