#### GOOD EVENING EVERYBODY:

Things are looking up on Cyprus. President Makarios has not reinstated the food blockade -- against Turkish communities on the island. Also Turkey has returned to Nato -- the Air Force units it withdrew at the height of theCyprus crisis. The Turkish planes that took part in air strikes -- gainst the Greek Cypriots. Greece will also -- return its Nato forces (withdrawn said the Greeks, to face the threat from Turkey. This could help break the vicious circle of reprisals and counter-reprisals -- that has been building up.)

Meanwhile the U.N. -- which negotiated with Makarios about the lifting of his blockade -- is delivering supplies of food and water to the Turkish Cypriots.

### U N FOLLOW CYPRUS

Tonight we hear that Turkey feels the time is ripe - for the U N to assume more power in Cyprus.

And Turkish Ambassador Orhan Eralp has asked Secretary General U Thant - to give his troops more authority to help the Turkish Cypriots. "A suitable international atmosphere now exists for such a move" - says the Ambassador.

# KHRUSHCHEV FOLLOW U N

The somewhat conciliatory attitude of the government of Cyprus - is indicative of a strategy decision in the Kremlin. So say these colebrated to the western diplomats in Moscow. Or at least those who are talking about the international situation.

The argument this lime goes like this:—

Makarios asked Khrushchev - for direct military aid.

A tempting request - because it offered the Russians a foothold in the Mediterranean island. With a chance to stir up animosity - between Greece and Turkey. And - weaken Nato.

But Khrushchev has had a book experience with another distant island - Cuba. Moreover he wants to cultivate good relations with the West - while his relations with Red China are gaiting works. Hence his decision - not to intervene in Cyprus.

A decision that leaves Makarios - high and dry;

and forces the head of the Cyprus government to take

a less belligerent line - with regard to the problem

of pacifying the his island.

Here is what may be the basic reason -- for Khrushchev staying out of the Cyprus cauldron. The Turks are threatening to close the Bosphorus -- to Soviet ships -- if -- Turkish security is endangered. And that has been a deadly threat to the Russians -- for centuries. Confronting them with the possibility -- of being trapped in the Black Sea, turned back from the historic waterway -- their outlet to the Mediterramean.

After them, the Bolsheviks -- did the same. But at this the Russians always have failed. The strategic strait remaining under the control of Turkey. Which could explain Khrushchev's reticence -- in the Cyprus crisis. He can't afford to have the Bosphorus -- closed to Russian shipping.

When the Soviet Union accuses the Chinese Reds of "racism" - the report seems straight forward enough. Mao Tse Tung as we know - is using the racial argument throughout Asia and Africa. Telling the non-white peoples - not to trust those Russians. Who - are rather obviously white.

But the extra ordinary thing about this Pravda
story - is that it accuses Mao of "racism in reverse."

The Moscow paper declaring that the boss of Red China
has thrown his support - to the white supremacy government
of South Africa. Image Tangible support - in the form
of dynamite. Explosives, according to Pravda - used
