Now this latest, Senator Kennedy issuing tonight his broadcast report to the people of Massachusetts - denying any impropiety - however telling his constituents his failure to report the accident was indefensible. Adding he has considered and is still considering - the possibility of resigning.

Including a description of the accident in which Mary Kopecknee Kopechne met her death - as read by Edgartown Police Chief Dominick Arena - who was then asked by the Judge: "Has there been any deliberate attempt - to conceal the identity of the defendent?" To which the Chief replied: "Not to my knowledge."

In the end - a two month jail sentence - sentence suspended. Judge Boyle observing: "The defendent will continue to be punished - far beyond anything this court could impose."

The Kennedy Kopechne case - thus officially closed: but none the less - far from finished. Indeed, a whole host of questions - still being asked tonight. So many, in fact, that Senator Kennedy has scheduled a broadcast in statement for just a few minutes from now. A broadcast described billed as a "report to the people of Massachusetts." And you can count on it - the whole nation - the whole world with be listening.
