On the political front - the President was

Republican Senator Dole of Kansas -- in a speech in at
San Francisco - challenging administration strategy during
the just-completed Campaign Seventy. Dole asserting
that the Administration should have emphasized more -
its accomplishments in winding down the war in Southeast
Asia. The fact that it failed to do so - said he -
permitting the Democrats to "emphasize unemployment
and inflation." Democrats - he went on - ultimately
using "scare tactics" that invoked visions of the bread
lines in the Thirties."

would have fared better - if it had only "put everything
in proper perspective." This, in effect, echoing a
weekend remark - by House and Urban Development
Secretary George Romney; who suggested that next time -
the Administration should "accentuate the positive."

And now, a quick shift to Key Biscayne; where we hear - perhaps the opening gun in Campaign Seventy-Two. The Florida White House saying President Nixon is convinced - his Vietnamization program is succeeding. Press Secretary Ron Ziegler adding that the President believes "that prior to nineteen seventy-two the South Vietnamese situation will be well under control". And thus "will not pose a problem to the United States - as it has for the past six years."

~~At the same time,~~ The President's remarks during a private interview late last week - published today back in Washington ^{are} ~~The President~~ quoted as ^{having} saying the big ~~xxx~~ issues in Seventy-Two - will be peace and the voters' pocket books. And on the first - said he - the administration will look "very strong." As for the second - the President conceding that the Democrats played brilliantly on ~~the~~ economic concerns

this year. But he also predicted - a major economic
upswing over the next two years; which will virtually

Elsewhere on the political scene - the "last
L.
hurrah" for veteran Negro congressman William Dawson
who died today in Chicago -- ~~for~~ following a lengthy
illness.

Democrat Bill Dawson - a native of Albany,
Georgia. Graduating from Fisk University - also,
the college of law at northwestern University. Serving
as a lieutenant of Infantry - during World War One.
Later entering politics in Chicago - where he won
election to alderman, first as a Republican and then
a Democrat. In Nineteen Forty-Two - finally entering
the House of Representatives; where he became eventually
- the first Negro ever to head a major congressional
committee. At his death - the oldest member of
Congress. William L. Dawson - age eighty-four.

SUPREME COURT

An attempt to contest the legality of the war in Vietnam was turned down flat today by the U S Supreme Court. This in connection with a ~~an~~ ^{Try} ~~attempt~~ by the State of Massachusetts - to prevent the sending of its young men to Vietnam. However, the High Court refusing by a vote of ~~six~~ six to three - even to consider the case.
