Tues, Sept. 9-75.

As promised - a Presidential veto today - in an attempt to head off a six month extension of oil price controls. The President saying: If ~~ix~~ I signed this bill - America's start on the road to energy independence could be delayed indefinitely."

Also, as promised - the House quickly voting to over-ride the President's veto; but the real battle ~~to~~<sup>will</sup> come tomorrow in the Senate. Senate Majority leader Mike ~~A~~ Mansfield saying: "It will be close - very close - but we are going to face up to this thing and see what happens."

MEANY FOLLOW ENERGY

On another front, the President met today with A F L ~~C~~ C I O head George Meany - and a number of ~~mar~~ maritime union leaders. The labor chieftains ~~agreed~~ agreeing to resume, "forthwith" - the loading of ships with U S grain bound for Russia. In return, the President pledging there will be no new grain sales to the Soviets - for at least a month. This to permit ~~for~~ further efforts to resolve the grain controversy - once and for all.

GENEVA

LEBANON

In northern Lebanon - hundreds of leftist ~~muslims~~ moslems today launched an attack on Zghorta the home town of Lebanon's christian President, Suleiman Franjeh. The moslems beaten back ~~for~~ by Christian militamen ~~but only~~ after heavy losses on both sides. Police saying the fighting ~~between~~ between Christians and Moslems has now left more than three ~~to~~ hundred dead or wounded.

From eastern Turkey comes <sup>word</sup> ~~a report~~ report  
~~today~~ telling of two remarkable rescues - in villages  
flattened by Saturday's earthquake. The first at  
Lice ~~Yaprakli~~ where three survivors were found trapped  
Leecha  
under a mound of rubble. The second at nearby  
Yaprakli - where four others were pulled from debris;  
These last <sup>one</sup> ~~including~~ a one hundred year old man,-  
and a four year old boy. A doctor saying: "They were  
mutilated and unconscious but miraculously alive."



PEKING

The tenth anniversary of the incorporation of Tibet into the Peoples Republic of China - was marked today by ~~ringing~~ editorials in Peking. The Chinese Communist Party newspaper calling Tibet - "an inalienable part of our ~~great~~ great motherland;" adding, the "motherland is steaming ahead - and so is the Socialist new Tibet." Also, saying the day of the Dalai Lama as a God King - "is now gone forever;" that he and his followers - can no longer "obstruct the advance of the wheel of history in Tibet."

Farther down though - the article admitting what we've known all along; that Tibetan opposition to Chinese rule - still persists even after all these years. Peking <sup>admitting the Tibetans refuse</sup> ~~saying: "The ~~so~~ overthrown call enemies~~ ~~will not ~~never~~~~ <sup>to</sup> reconcile ~~themselves~~ themselves" - to the unification of Tibet with China." <sup>That</sup> ~~Stressing~~ it is, therefore, necessary to maintain a constant "vigilant<sup>u</sup>" lest the Tibetan<sup>s</sup> again reassert their independence.

## TOPEKA

Republican elder statesman Alf Landon - age eighty-eight today; ~~an occasion he~~ celebrated with the help of about seventy youngsters - from Landon Junior High School near his home in Topeka.

Landon telling his young guests: "We have something in common - despite nearly eighty years difference" in age; <sup>an</sup> ~~and that - he continued - the~~ opportunity to witness revolutionary advances in man's horizons. At the beginning of the century - the introduction of the first horseless carriages; and now - the advent of trips to the ~~near~~ moon. Landon telling the youngsters: "You are seeing not only a new world - but a new universe."



## TITUSVILLE

At Titusville, Florida an attempt by police to demonstrate to local business men - how easy it is to get away with ~~sp~~ shoplifting.
