### GOOD EVENING EVERYBODY:

Before we take off for the big game country here in East Africa, I have a rather startling bit of information for you - something that has almost nothing to do with Africa, nothing at all to do with big game. As you no doubt know there are many many Mohammedans in East Africa, or Moslems I should say. As you no doubt have heard Mohammedanism, in recent years, has been spreading more rapidly than any other religion.

A distinguished Moslem friend of mine, whom I have known for many years, has just come from the Holy Arabian city of Mecca. In fact, his family has a home in Mecca, right near the Mosque of the Kaaba, which includes the Sacred Black Rock, that is covered with the Holy Carpet, that is where Moslems who visit Mecca say their prayers.

As you know, ever since the days of the Prophet Mohammed, Mecca: has been a forbidden city to all non-Moslems. Not only Mecca, but also the Arabian city of Medina, several hundred miles north of Mecca -- Medina, where Mohammed died and was buried. Since the days of the Prophet, pictures have been forbidden in Holy Arabia - pictures associated with idolatry. In the past few decades this has changed a little. But not much, not much in Holy Mecca and Medina.

Now for the startling information. At any rate, startling to me: King Feisal, who recently ascended the throne, but who has actually been the ruler of Saudi Arabia for the past year and a half, Feisal seems determined to modernize Arabia. He is even building motion picture theaters right in the Holy City of Mecca, and also in Medina. And to all who are familiar with the story of Arabia, this is indeed incredible.

A sidelight on this that may give you some idea of how difficult King Feisal may find it to do what he wants to do. A Moslem cameraman made a journey to Medina from another country. He made a long expensive trip just to get a still photograph of the tomb of the prophet, in the great Mosque at Medina. And when he told the Immam who presides over the Mosque what he wanted to do, the Immam replied that he would give him exactly a minute and a half in which to do it. Of course the photographer laughed and assumed that this was not to be taken too literally. But when the minute and a half was up, the Immam said, "out you go", and out he went without his picture.

But King Feisal is determined to modernize his oil-rich country -- and Feisal is a determined man. And I predict that he will do it. Before too long, why, we may even be able to do what has been forbidden for more than a thousand years. We may someday be invited to

Are the continents of the earth in constant motion?

Is the interior of the earth heating up or coolind down?

What causes the twenty major earthquakes that shake our

planet each year? And what about the million other tremors?

These questions were posed today by a panel of fifty geophysicists affiliated with the National Academy of Sciences. To find the answers, they proposed a \$650 million ten-year research program into the subterranean mysteries of the earth. The proposed study would include super-deep drilling operations to a depth of from eight to ten miles, enabling scientists to better examine the unknown forces operating within the earth's crust - and they suggested more, that the program might eventually pay for itself, through improved methods of "prospecting for natural resources".
