**SANTIAGO**

*Revolution in Santiago as you no doubt have heard by now. Chile's armed forces today staging a bloody revolt -- against the regime of Marxist President Salvadore Allende. Finally storming the Presidential palace - after a three hour ground and air attack. Immediately announcing the formation of a new government - to remove, as the pronouncement says: "the yolk of Communism."*

*As for the fate of Allende himself - that remains as yet unclear.*

*The deposed President earlier saying "only dead will they take me out."*

*There already has been a report of his committing suicide. However the new government merely says: Allende has "surrendered."*


**PEKING**

**President Pompidou of France today became the first western ~~man~~ European leader - ever to visit Red China; arriving in Peking - to a cheering welcome by thousands of Chinese children. Pompidou later ~~the~~ guest of ~~the~~ honor at a state dinner <sup>given</sup> ~~hosted~~ by Red China's Premier Chou En Lai. The French President raising a toast to increased French and Chinese cooperation. Whereupon a Chou response - coming as something of a surprise.**

**The Chinese Premier telling his guest :**

**"There is one more important link between us:**

**We both are attached to our independence and our sovereignty - and we shall not allow any super power to subject us to its control."**



**ADD PEKING**

**Chou also referring to the present "detente" between the U S and Russia; calling it - "only a superficial phenomenon. "The danger of war remains" = he continued. Adding that China is therefore digging deep ~~under~~ underground shelters - as well as stockpiling grain reserves.**

## WHITE HOUSE

*Former Texas Governor Connolly was at the White House today. President Nixon reportedly hearing Governor Connolly was in town - called him in to discuss "some economic problems" and foreign policy matters. This leading to the possibility that Connolly might ~~be~~ go abroad soon - as the President's personal emissary.*

*Definite plans not yet firm - we are told. The White House adding, however, that Connolly would most likely travel to Europe and the Middle East some time later this year - carrying with him - "some messages" from the President. All of which is seen as a boost for Connolly - as he eyes the Nineteen Seventy-Six Presidential race.*

## **PRESIDENT FOLLOW WHITE HOUSE**

*The President also met today with some two hundred delegates to a White House conference on street crime. The President saying the nation has finally "turned the corner" on drug abuse. This he attributes to a three-pronged campaign of law enforcement, treatment and elimination of drug sources.*

*The President adding however, that the drug problem has not been eliminated. Still a long way to go. But having turned the corner, said he "we are going on down the road = until the whole nation realizes drug abuse is under control."*

## TAPES

In the ~~the~~ case of the ~~President's~~ disputed tapes and documents, <sup>today there was a</sup> ~~the~~ presentation of oral arguments. White House lawyer Charles Alan Wright telling a circuit court of appeals - a President's confidentiality is "absolutely essential to effective functioning." Also, quoting from the late J F K when he said: "The heart of the presidency - is prudent, resolute and informed choice."

Wright adding: "This is what this case is all about - not whether we are Democrats or admirers of President Nixon." And "the decision this court is called upon to make" he continued <sup>is</sup> ~~is~~ "one which will have tremendous lasting effect on the American presidency."

Secretary of State. The White House agreeing to permit  
two Senators - to see a secret F B I wire-tapping  
report dating back to Nineteen Sixty-Nine. This in  
connection with several ~~members~~ members of Dr.  
Kissinger's staff - one of whom was suspected of  
leaking secret information. The White House thereby  
hoping to mollify - Chairman ~~J. W. Fulbright~~ Fulbright of the  
Senate Foreign Relations Committee; who had otherwise  
threatened - to hold up the ~~the~~ nomination.

## **EARTH ORBIT**

*In the flight of America's Sky Lab Two - a photo sweep today over drought stricken Northern Africa. Mission Commander Alan Bean saying: ~~What~~ "We're not going to make it rain. But, we think from Sky Lab we can look down with suitable sensors - and determine areas which have high possibility of water tables not too distant below;" areas - he continued - "good for digging wells, or the planting of crops."*

*That done - still another photo sweep. The Astronauts taking pictures of snow fields in Switzerland - the better to predict avalanches and spring ~~flow~~ flooding - also photographing the plain in Spain and pollution in Germany - to help man better ~~now~~ understand his environment.*



**DETROIT**

**A top official of the United Auto Workers in Detroit was giving instructions today on how to wage a "peaceful" strike. U A W Secretary-Treasurer Emil Mazey briefing local officials in the ~~face~~ face of a threatened strike against Chrysler as of Friday night. This - in the midst of continuing negotiations. **A U S protest note was delivered today to the North Vietnamese embassy in Paris - and later made public in Saigon. The U S note also demanding the removal of Missiles and anti-aircraft -- said to have been "illegally introduced into South ~~Vietnam~~ Vietnam." A similar protest - coming from South Vietnam; which further said it was ready, if necessary, to take appropriate measures - put a stop to the new Communist threat.**

## **GUADALUPE ISLAND**

**The recent winner of the U S national spear-fishing championships -- now the victim of a shark attack off the Guadalupe Islands. Albert Schnepfershoff - while skin diving with friends. Bitten in the leg his death followed quickly, due to hem<sup>m</sup>orrhaging and shock.**

**Albert Schnepfershoff - only thirty-seven; the first person known to have been killed by a shark in California waters in many years.**
