The New York Stock Market staged a strong rally today with the Dow Jones average registering its best gain since last April. The upsurge was generally attributed to a statement made today by the incoming Federal Reserve Chairman ~~Arthur~~ <sup>Who</sup> Burns ~~He~~ told the Senate Banking Committee the government may soon reconsider its tight money policy after getting more facts on the tax reform bill and the new federal budget.

## SHORTAGE

There will be plenty of teachers available in the Nineteen Seventies but there is likely to be a continuing shortage of doctors, engineers and scientists. Labor Department spokesmen say an estimated two hundred fifty thousand new doctors will be needed- with the number ~~but the supply~~ of trained physicians ~~is expected to~~ fall <sup>ing far</sup> short of this.

~~enact~~ a special ~~police~~ force for this purpose. The  
measure now goes to the Senate.
