Senator Ervin adding that -"the pardon aids and abets the efforts of those - who sought to hide the truth; and thus continues - the cover-up."

On the other hand the republican whip,

Senator Griffin was saying the former President and the nation - "would have been unable to withstand prolonged indecision." Senator Griffin adding that President

Ford's decision - was a "tough one to make." "But,"
he added, "history will judge his action and I believe
he will fare well in the judgment."

transit. The anti-pardon demonstrators also chanting:

thought initially - and he wants to be personally
involved in the entire matter; so, there will be no
announcement tomorrow," as originally planned.
