In the U N debate on the Middle East ~~there was~~ <sup>the</sup> a Russian call today for speedy resumption of Geneva peace talks - with Palestinian participation. Russia's Yakov Malik saying: "Without the full participation of the Palestinian people - it will be impossible to settle the middle east problem; adding that failure to recognize this - is "tantamount to coming out against a just and lasting peace."

Israel's Chaim Herzog who is boycotting the official debate - ~~was~~ <sup>ed</sup> calling a news conference <sup>at which he</sup> insisting that Israel is not ~~not~~ opposed to talking to Palestinians - merely <sup>to</sup> the Palestine liberation army. "Israel has a ~~10~~ million and a quarter Palestinians" - he continued - "we talk to Palestinians every day." But, "we do not recognize the ~~PLO~~ P L O - as ~~representing~~ representing the Palestinian people."

SAN FRANCISCO

Sara Jane Moore ~~was~~ sentenced today to life in prison - for attempting to assassinate President Ford last September in San Francisco.
