This measure - said the President - "the
single most valuable housing legislation in our history."

A major breakthrough - said he "in the drive to see that every family in America - lives in a home of dignity -
a neighborhood of pride - a community of opportunity and a city of promise and hope."

In somewhat the same vein - Commerce Secretary
John Connor today urged the passage of $\mathbf{x} \dot{\boldsymbol{x}}$ legislation -
that would ban bill boards from the nation's highways.

Also establish minimum controls - over roadside junk
yards. While prod providing additional federal funds
for the construction of scenic roads. All this - said donor - to turn out highways into "open windows" - clean windows - to the beauty of our can country.

Too often in the past - said he, "the view from our highways has been marred by barren landscapes,
automobile grave yards, a conglomeration of billboar 's and other unsightly clutter, a careless destruction of our God-given and man-made beauty." The public -he concluded - wants something better and ought to get it.

The Senate Judiciary Committee today unanimously
