GOOD EVENING EVERYBODY :

The security council of the United Nations began its hearing, today - in the dispute over aerial espionage - the U.N. and the U-2.

Soviet Foreign Minister Gromyko led off - with the Moscow accusation against the United States. Gromyko - not as frantic as Khrushchev. But - using similar phraseology. Calling American policy - "pirate-like."

In a speech an hour long, he called upon the Security Council to condemn the aerial surveillance as aggression. Also - to make the United States discontinue the espionage flights.

As we know - in Paris, President Eisenhower stated - that the flights had been stopped, and would not be resumed. But the Soviets insist on taking the view - that the discontinuance was only temporary.

RETORTING TO THAT, SENATOR DIRKSEN SAID -- THAT STEVENSON DID HIS SHARE TO TORPEDO THE TOP LEVEL PALAVER IN ADVANCE, WHEN HE DECLARED, IN PARIS -- THAT THE WESTERN POWERS SHOULD MAKE SUBSTANTIAL CONCESSIONS TO KHRUSHCHEV IN THE BERLIN QUESTION, IN RETURN -- FOR A BAN ON ATOMIC TESTING. STEVENSON --QUOTED IN A PARIS NEWSPAPER.

today : IN DEFENSE OF STEVENSON SENATE DEMOCRATIC LEADER

MIKE MANSFIELD AND SENATOR SYMINGTON, A CANDIDATE FOR THE DEMOCRATIC NOMINATION. THEY REPLYING -- THAT STEVENSON DENIES HE EVER SAID ANY SUCH THING. CLAIMS -- HE WAS MISQUOTED.

THERE WAS ALSO A REPUBLICAN CHARGE THAT SENATOR KENNEDY, FRONT-RUNNER FOR THE DEMOCRATIC NOMINATION, MADE A STATEMENT IN OREGON -- THAT PRESIDENT EISENHOWER SHOULD APOLOGIZE TO KHRUSHCHEV. THE DEMOCRATS SHOUTING -- THAT NO DEMOCRAT EVER SAID THAT.

WHAT AROUSED THEIR IRE THE MOST WAS A DIRKSEN SUGGESTION --THAT KHRUSHCHEV OUGHT TO HOLD A SUMMIT CONFERENCE AFTER THE U. S. ELECTION. HOPING THAT A DEMOCRAT WILL GET IN. AND BE -- EASIER TO DEAL WITH. THE DEMOCRATS ROARED IN PROTEST -- AGAINST THAT. WELL, THE WHOLE BOILING POT WOULD SEEM TO SIMMER DOWN TO ONE THING. CONGRESS WILL HOLD AN INVESTIGATION, TO DETERMINE WHAT HAPPENED -- IN THE AFFAIR OF THE U-2. THE SERIES OF MI SADVENTURES -- WHICH WAS FOLLOWED BY THE BLOW-UP ON THE SUMMIT. TODAY, THE REPUBLICAN LEADER SAID HE THOUGHT -- THAT WAS THE PROPER COMMITTEE TO CONDUCT AN INQUIRY. IF THE DEMOCRATS --"WANT TO HAVE ONE", AS SENATOR DIRKSEN PUT IT. BUT LATER HE DECLARED -- HE DOUBTED THERE SHOULD BE ANY INQUIRY AT ALL.

PRESIDENT EISENHOWER WILL MAKE HIS RADIO-TELEVISION ADDRESS ON WEDNESDAY NIGHT. EXPLAINING TO THE PEOPLE OF THIS COUNTRY --THE COLLAPSE OF THE SUMMIT CONFERENCE. WHEREUPON, IT WAS BESET -- BY SIX RUSSIAN JET FIGHTERS. WHICH -- FIRED WARNING SHOTS, HEMMING IN THE TRANSPORT -- AND FORCING IT LOWER AND LOWER. UNTIL IT WAS COMPELLED TO LAND --IN A GRAIN FIELD, UNDAMAGED. THE OCCUPANTS -- ARRESTED.
