## UNEMPLOYMENT

The U.S. unemployment rate - up again last month; to Nine-point-Two Per Cent - the highest ~~figure~~ since prior to World War Two. But

Government expert Julius Shiskin notes, ~~however~~, a simultaneous increase of more than three hundred thousand - in the nation's total work force. Also, a sharp increase in the number of persons working full-time - as opposed to part-time just a month ago. Shiskin saying this ~~strongly~~ suggests "the recession has reached bottom," - ~~and possible~~ Recovery ~~has~~ started."



## SENATE
