In the harbor - hundreds of small craft snapped their anchors, and - were washed out to sea.

A ten-thousand ton freighter rammed others as it drifted from one side of the harbor to the other.

The toll of injured and dead - running into the thousands. Homeless - hundreds of thousands. Typhoon Gloria pays a visit to Formosa.
