Britain's House of Commons - the scene of a brief flurry of excitement today; when a man sitting in the visitors gallery - apparently an Irish Catholic sympathizer - hurled two tear gas bombs onto the House floor.

WHITE HOUSE

Finland's longtime President - Urho Kekkonen - a guest today at the White House for the first time in nine years. President Nixon welcoming the Finnish chief of state - as "one of the world's most respected leaders." He also thanked Kekkonen - for hosting the initial round of Strategic Arms Limitation Talks earlier this year. The President observing that "this conference may lead to an historic agreement between the U.S. and the Soviet Union - which will contribute to peace in years to come."

In return, Kekkonen alluding briefly to the fact - that he recently signed a new friendship with the Soviet Union; asserting that Finland is also bound by lasting ties of friendship with the U.S. Kekkonen adding: "There are no problems between us." ~~If not a unique situation - surely, a rare one these days.~~

~~Elsewhere in Washington~~ - Attorney General John Mitchell announced ~~today~~ the filing of charges - against thirteen members of the radical Weatherman group; ~~These~~ accused of conspiracy to ~~commit bombings~~ in four cities: Chicago - New York - Detroit - and Berkeley, California. Fifteen others - also named as co-conspirators. A Federal indictment charging that they intended to "use bombs, destructive devices and explosives - to destroy police installations and other civic, business and educational buildings throughout the country; and to kill and injure - persons therein."

UTTAR PRADESH

The death toll in that flash flood in India's Uttar Pradesh State - now set at more than five hundred. Indian news agencies identifying the victims as mostly pilgrims - who had just visited a famed Hindu shrine ^{at} Badrinath.

In at least one instance - we are told - a caravan of buses receiving advance warning of the approaching floodwaters in plenty of time Police advising the pilgrims inside - to head for higher land. About four hundred - doing just that.

NUTRITION

From the Academy of Clinical Nutrition in Washington
- the results of a diet study among the nation's doctors and
dentists. This in an attempt to check whether the most
affluent nation in history - is eating as well as it should;
using doctors and dentists as a guide - since they are both
more affluent and more health-minded than most - ~~or~~^{as} it was
thought.

Anyway, the study showing that an average doctor or
dentist - consumes about twenty-three hundred calories ~~per day~~^{a day};
as compared with the twenty-six hundred - that is generally
considered a healthy amount. The study further concluding
that forty-three per cent - do not get enough Vitamin A;
sixty-five per cent - do not get enough calcium; and ninety-
nine per cent of their wives - who were also checked - are
failing to get enough iron.

Summing up, Dr. Emanuel Cheraskin observing: "It
is practically impossible - for an American to eat a
well-balanced diet in our culture today." The doctors adding:
