The White House - President Nixon issued today another "inflation alert" - his second, to date.

This one taking to task - the United Auto Workers recent wage settlement with General Motors; which was called clearly inflationery. The report adding that subsequent auto price increases - could cause more and more Americans to switch to foreign make cars.

The President's special bulletin also citing

wage increases - now averaging about seven percent

throughout the economy; calling these-incompatible

with a stabile price level; as further demonstrated

by recent price increases - in the fuel industry, in local

transportation, in copper mining.

The report finally urging both labor and management - to exercise voluntary restraint in wage and price policy; and thereby set the surge for renewed economic growth - that could also solve our present

unemployment problem.

A related item: Chairman Wilbur Mills

today that U S spending on health care has jumped

more than seven billion in the past year along; to the

point - said he -- where it now accounts for a full

seven percent of the gross national product. Mills

saying this has been caused by "rapidly escalating

costs -- and rapidly increasing public involvment."
