

*Tues. Dec. 1st '70.*

*The White House - President Nixon issued today another "inflation alert" - his second, to date. This one taking to task - the United Auto Workers recent wage settlement with General Motors; which was called clearly inflationary. The report adding that subsequent auto price increases - could cause more and more Americans to switch to foreign make cars.*

*The President's special bulletin also citing wage increases - now averaging about seven percent throughout the economy; calling these-incompatible with a stable price level; as further demonstrated by recent price increases - in the fuel industry, in local transportation, in copper mining.*

*The report finally urging both labor and management - to exercise voluntary restraint in wage and price policy; and thereby set the stage for renewed economic growth - that could also solve our present unemployment problem.*

## MILLS FOLLOW BOSTON

*A related item: Chairman Wilbur Mills of the House Ways and Means committee reporting today that U S spending on health care has jumped more than seven billion in the past year alone<sup>2</sup>; to the point - said he -- where it now accounts for a full seven percent of the gross national product. Mills saying this has been caused by "rapidly escalating costs -- and rapidly increasing public involvement."*

## WASHINGTON

*A new system of forecasting sudden, often disastrous East Coast storms - announced today by the National Weather Service; a system that depends on weather information - supplied by one - an automated data buoy about a hundred miles off the Virginia-North Carolina border; two a weather ship on permanent station about two hundred miles east of the Virginia Cape<sup>S</sup>; and three - Air Force and Navy aerial reconnaissance flights - whenever there's a potential storm.*

*These additions to previously existing procedures- said to be capable of giving the "earliest warning ever;" According to the weather services, Dr. George Cressman - anywhere from twelve to twenty-four hours advance notice; where in past days - there was often times no advance notice at all.*

## CHULAI\_PARIS

*The war news from South Vietnam was marked today by an enemy rocket attack -- on the headquarters of the U S American<sup>n</sup> Division at Chulai. One of the incoming shells hitting a dispensary - we are told -- killing or wounding all U S medical personnel on duty therein. While in Paris - America's David Bruce was charging that two years of alleged peace talks - have given Hanoi a propaganda "field day." But "there has been so far" said he - "no negotiation whatsoever."*

Later on, the Pope himself addressing a  
throng of worshippers - gathered at a wind-swept  
Sydney racetrack. There condemning a so-called "white  
Australia" immigration policy <sup>that</sup><sub>^</sub> in effect <sup>bar</sup><sub>^</sub> ~~ring~~<sup>s</sup>  
practically all non-Caucasians. "Do not" - he told his  
Australian audience - "Do not close your limited circle -  
for the sake of selfish satisfaction."

## BOSTON

Up at Boston - a meeting of the ruling House of Delegates of the American Medical Association; ~~which~~ adopted a report today ~~A~~ warning doctors "against the pitfalls of undue concern with the financial aspect of medical practice;" as evidenced we are told - by cases of doctors who charged their patients one and a half percent monthly interest - who accept as new patients only those with good credit ratings - who refused to see old patients <sup>'til</sup> ~~though~~ they've paid up their old bills.

The report then <sup>does</sup> ~~goes~~ on to say that such examples are still exceptions to the rule. "Nonetheless - these practices affect adversely ~~on~~ the whole profession"- it adds; "and especially ~~on~~ the countless physicians who extend credit willingly or write off old accounts - because they are dedicated to mankind."
