Washington, Moscow, London, a grand step today in the direction of worldwide disarmament. The U.S., Russia and Britain - as well as fifty-seven other nations - signing a new treaty banning nuclear weapons from ocean floor.

In Moscow - Soviet Premier Kosygin calling the pact - a key move "toward the complete all over the globe. demilitarization of the seabed," In Washington -President Nixon expressing hope that this will pave the way - "sometime in the future - for the final great step - the control of all nuclear arms on earth."

Meanwhile, South Vietnamese troops H were their continuing to push ahead today in Laos, and reports, closing in from three sides H on a suspected Communist base at Sepone in Laos, This said to serve as a key transfer point H on the enemy's Ho Chi Min supply trail.

Battlefield observers adding a major clash and be in the offing.

At the peace table in Paris - another exercise in futility today. America's David Bruce later telling reporters "The other side announced even in advance - that they intended not negotiations but polemics, instead." And he added: "That's what we got from them."

Procest Bruce then going on to say: "Whenever Hanoi tries to condemn our side's actions in regard to Laos and Cambodia - without even mentioning the massive and longstanding North Vietnamese presence there - they are engaging in pure hypocrisy." And he further said: "The fighting and killing in Indochina go on" - for one reason and one reason alone; the fact that "Hanoi refuses to accept a cease-fire - and refuses to negotiate seriously."

WHITE HOUSE

In spite of all this - the war in Vietnam will end someday - they all do. And so a new job - for former Kennedy Treasury Secretary David Secretary; who was sworn in as a U.S. Ambassador-at-Large - in ceremonies today at the White House. His firs assignment - to make an extended tour of South Vietnam. President Nixon saying: "The next primary problem in South Vietnam" - will be the development of a viable post-war economy. And he added that "there is nobody in our government - better qualified" to serve as an adviser on this.
