BUT NOT HIM, NOT YIM. WHEN HE SPILLED AND WENT HURTLING OFF THE COURSE, HE GOT UP, SHOOK HIMSELF, CLIMBED BACK TO WHERE HE HAD SPILLED, AND UNDAUNTED ON DOWN HE CAME. I've skied both courses - down Squaw from the summit - and down KT 22, and I take my hat offym TP KYUNG SOON YIM IS FROM SOUTH KOREA, WHERE THEIR MOUNTAINS ARE NOT SO

HIGH, AND THERE ARE FEW RACES TO GIVE A FELLOW A CHANCE TO TRAIN FOR THE OLYMPICS.
