of about three thousand militant anti-war protestors

- today swarmed around the $U$ S Justice Department for
some three hours - some chanting obscenities and some
demanding an end to the Vietnam war. Whereupon - an
order from Attorney General John Mitchell was followed by a police announcement telling the protestors - to "clear the area immediately or, "you are subject to
arrest." In a matter of minutes - the crowd dwindling
to a thousand or so. Then the police moved in - using
tear gas and their billies - where it was felt necessary;
arresting the demonstrators and hauling them off to jail
by the bus load. All this as their leaders were making
plans for another demonstration tomorrow - on Capitol Hill.

As for congress, reaction to wownent, -
was growing stronger today. Senate Minority
leader Hugh Scott for one - lashing out at certain
Democratic leaders? whom he accused of praising these quote

felt it was "politically advantageous." Scott lax adding
that - in any case, the protestors will soon learn
