UNITED NATIONS

After twice threatening to resign--Daniel Moynihan has made it three strikes and out. The U.S. Ambassador to the U.N.--turning in his resignation to President Ford. That makes sixteen of the rebels - who have now paid with their lives; and nearly a hundred more <sup>and</sup> still facing charges.
