And, <sup>today came</sup> From the White House <sup>an</sup> administration  
"white paper?" ~~today~~ - on housing. President Nixon  
taking note of a recent supreme court ruling - saying  
the government will not attempt to force on local  
communities - so-called "economic integration;" meaning  
housing projects they may not want. - ~~how housing~~  
~~projects intended solely for the poor.~~

At the same time - the President continued  
- "we will not countenance any use of economic measures  
-- as a subterfuge for racial discrimination;" for  
this is "wrong" - said he; also, "constitutionally  
indefensible - and pragmatically unwise."

In short, the President pledging to strive  
for - "equal housing opportunity" for all. And this  
he defined as "the achievement of a condition - in  
which individuals of similar income levels shall have  
a like range of housing choices - regardless of race,  
COLOR, religion or national origin."

told his audience that  
~~University. Neil Armstrong saying~~ the U S

as it once did <sup>neglected</sup> the airplane. <sup>For</sup> ~~for~~ ~~man~~ manned space  
flight - said he - is "an enormously powerful  
and ~~purposeful~~ versatile new capability, of immense  
consequence.

Neil Armstrong adding that "space faring  
- just as seafaring and aeronautics earlier in  
history - is ~~moving forward on the state of human~~  
~~affairs~~ adding a new dimension to our economic  
cultural and spiritual potential<sup>al</sup>;" and anything that  
can do that - said he - "is not a toy to be <sup>lightly</sup> ~~lightly~~
