*At a White House meeting today some three hundred U.S. industrial leaders; heard a prediction from President Ford - that the U.S. economy will stage a remarkable comeback by the end of the year. The "one area of major concern" - said he - "the lack of positive congressional action on energy." Adding: "When we talk about energy - we're talking about jobs."*

the C.I.A. - were within its authority. Also, ~~saying~~ *that* -

"There is no credible evidence of C.I.A. involvement" *^*

in either the assassination of President Kennedy or the

Watergate breakin. ~~Adding, however,~~ *But that* the C.I.A. had

engaged in "plainly unlawful and improper" domestic

activities; "some" at the instigation of past Presidents -

"either directly or indirectly."

The Rockefeller report further making thirty

"recommendations" - on how to improve and contain the

C.I.A. *^* Among them, ~~a call for~~ the creation of a new

- joint congressional "oversight" body; and, additional

checks and balances - to guard against ~~any~~ future

"deviations." The report ~~concluding, nevertheless,~~ *does* *^* *that* *^*

good intelligence agency is vital to the nation's security.

~~Capitol Hill~~ The HOuse failed today ~~but just~~  
~~barely~~ in an attempt to override the President's veto  
of that new strip mining bill. The final talley ~~coming out~~  
two-hundred-and-seventy-eight in favor of the bill - ~~only~~  
a-hundred-and-forty-three against. ~~The President's~~  
~~margin of victory thus a scant three votes - but still a~~  
~~decisive win. This marking~~ **T**he third time this year -
