On Capitol Hill - vindication at last. Richard Kleindienst winning confirmation today - as a member of the President's cabinet. After waiting nearly four months - an all-time record, <sup>Now</sup>~~becoming~~ officially the new U S Attorney General. Best of all, perhaps, the Senate finally approving his nomination - by a vote of sixty-four to nineteen; a vote that Kleindienst himself later said - left him "humbled and flattered."

The new Attorney General further stating that understandably "I'm glad ~~that~~ it's over." Adding: "I'm also deeply ~~grate~~ grateful for the opportunity now to go back to work; to get on with <sup>the</sup> very serious business of the administration of justice in the United States."

~~House~~ <sup>again</sup> Capitol Hill - the House passed and sent to President Nixon today - a controversial anti-bussing measure. This - as part of a higher ~~education~~ education bill; an attempt to block funds for court-ordered bussing in cases still subject to appeal.

If signed by the President, as expected - ~~it~~ <sup>it will</sup> remain in effect at least ~~until~~ till January one, Nineteen Seventy-Four. <sup>^</sup> The Supreme Court willing, of course.

## POLITICS

McGovern ~~has~~ <sup>today first</sup> arranged to meet with Edmund Muskie -  
~~and then Hubert~~ <sup>^</sup> Humphrey.

ready now to quit the race; in which case, presumably -

he would then throw his support to McGovern. ~~And~~

when asked for comment though - Muskie replying:

"Oh heavens - no." Adding: "I made a decision several  
weeks ~~ago~~ ago to continue the candidacy and that  
decision still stands."

*Lest there be any doubt --  
Humphrey adding that he too is  
still in it.*

AIDE

Meanwhile a legal aide to Hubert Humphrey ~~was~~ announcing plans to challenge California's unit rule system; On the grounds - we are told - ~~that~~ that Humphrey received forty percent of the California vote and therefore, should get at least forty percent of California's total two-hundred-and-seventy-one delegates. The Humphrey man adding - this is clearly specified in new party rules; new rules which were drawn up incidentally, ~~and~~ under the direction of ~~the~~ George McGovern.

## VIETNAM

U S air action in Vietnam - the heaviest today in more than two weeks. Some three hundred American jets - in all - blasting enemy targets the length and breadth of the Communist North. In one case, using so-called "smart bombs" hitting actually inside a key ~~key~~ railroad tunnel.
