TELEGRAM

*Thirty-seven U.S. Senators made an appeal today to Russia's Brezhnev, to allow Andrei Sakharov to go to Oslo next month - to receive his Nobel peace prize. This on the grounds that Sakharov's right to travel - is clearly within the scope and provisions of the recent Helsinki accords. The Senators adding: "Indeed, the Sakharov case is an important test of Soviet intentions" - indeed of detente, in general.*

ANKARA

*U.S. and Turkish officials met today in Ankara -  
to discuss the possible reopening of those U.S. military  
bases. This the third round of such talks.*

JERUSALEM

In the Middle East - Jerusalem - U N Secretary General ~~Gen~~ Kurt Waldheim met today with top Israeli officials. Waldheim bringing with him some Syrian suggestions - relating to a renewal of the U N peace keeping mandate on the Golan Heights. ~~But~~ These - ~~apparently~~ apparently unacceptable to Israel. ~~At~~ any rate, Waldheim later saying he <sup>if</sup> ~~would have to~~ return to Damascus - "~~in order~~<sup>(1)</sup> to clarify a number of points."

SRI CHIANG MAI

The Thai city of Sri Chiang Mai near the scene of a clash last week between Thai and Laotian troops. Also, the home of a number of Vietnamese - who sought refuge there after the first IndoChina War. The Vietnamese now suspected of sympathizing with Laos - and thus the target ~~of a rampage~~ today ~~of~~ Thai mobs.
