CAPITOL HILL

A compromise bill to provide some additional aid to Cambodia -- was rejected today by the House Foreign Affairs Committee. The final vote - eighteen to fifteen. And then, ^{from} ~~on~~ the Senate ~~side~~ - more of the same. Senate Democrats meeting ⁱⁿ caucus ~~to~~ voting more than seven to one against any additional aid to Cambodia.

White House reaction relayed by spokesman Ron Nessen - ^{was that} ~~who said~~ the President was "terribly disappointed." Officially though, ~~at~~ the President ^{is} said to be still hoping ^{Congress} ~~that~~ eventually ~~Congress~~ will approve additional aid to Cambodia and South Vietnam; ~~and~~ hopefully - before it's too late.

SENATE

After lo these many ^{months} ~~years~~ - the Senate Finance Committee today began to write a new tax cut bill. Committee chairman Russell Long - urging a thirty billion dollar tax cut; nearly half ~~again~~ again as much as "as they^{re} still talking about over the in House." Long also letting it be ~~be~~ known he hopes to have a tax cut on the President's ~~to~~ desk - by the end of next week.

HUMPHREY

Senator Humphrey of Minnesota - in a way, a
victim today of the Watergate fallout. The Internal
Revenue Service - disallowing a Humphrey ^{tax} deduction
of nearly two hundred thousand bucks, ~~that~~ in

- to the Minnesota Historical Society. ^{Sen.} Humphrey

PHILAE
